If you have lower to upper intermediate English skills (completion of ELSA level 4 or at levels 5 & 6) and need to learn how to job search in Canada, we are here to help you!

The First Step Employment Program includes 4 weeks (Monday through Friday, 9am –2:30pm) of in-class instruction involving

- Job search skills: learn to write a résumé and cover letter, develop effective interview skills and self-marketing skills for the Hidden and Visible Job Markets
- Learning to use Internet to research and apply to jobs and employers
- Scheduled time for independent job search
- 24 hours (4 days) of English for the Workplace and Job Search

Following the in-class part of the program, if you are still unemployed:

- 4 weeks of job search support through weekly one-to-one sessions
- Job placement assistance
