- Learning to use Internet to research and apply to jobs and employers
- Scheduled time for independent job search
- English for the Workplace and Job Search (4 days)
- Developing an understanding of Canadian Workplace culture

Following the in-class part of the program, if you are still unemployed:

- 4 weeks of job search support through weekly one-to-one sessions
- Job placement assistance
